Here, each one may also receive a physical gesture of healing: the laying on of hands, which may be accompanied by anointing with oil. These signs, first given in baptism, tell us again that we are sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked forever with the cross of Christ, who is health and salvation for the world. If there is a need for healing for yourself, or a loved one, please come for prayer and anointing during communion distribution. We will have members of our prayer team with a pastor to provide an opportunity for prayer.
