A Time of Silent Reflection




Rock of our salvation,

WORDS OF INSTITUTION

THE LORD'S PRAYER:

DISTRIBUTION:

If you are worshiping at home, prepare the table with bread or a cracker and wine or grape juice. If you are worshiping in-person, peel back the first layer of plastic for the bread. For the wine peel back the second layer.

Take the bread in your hands and hear the word of Jesus:

The body of Christ, broken for you. Now receive the bread.

Take the cup and hear again the word of Jesus:

The blood of Christ, shed for you. Now drink the cup.

POST COMMUNION BLESSING AND PRAYER:

We give you thanks, gracious God, for we have feasted on the abundance of your house. Send us to bring good news and to proclaim your favor to all, strengthened with the richness of your grace in your Son, Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

BENEDICTION:

God, who leads you in pathways of righteousness, who rejoices over you, and who calls you by name, † bless your going out and your coming in, today and forever. **Amen.**
