Summer 2023 Children's Ministry Intern

Job Descriptions and Application Process

Zion Lutheran Church will be selecting a number of interns to assist with summer programming in the children's ministry area.

Intern Positions

Intern 1: Must be a high school graduate prior to starting the position (class of 2023). Beginning and ending dates are June 12-Aug. 17, 2023. Work hours vary each week, but are generally from 8 am-1 pm, M-Th, for a total of 130 hours.

Intern 2: Must have a least one year of post-secondary education. Beginning and ending dates are June 12-Aug. 17, 2023. Work hours vary each week, but are generally from 8 am-1 pm, M-Th, for a total of 140 hours.

Lead Intern: Must have a least one year of post-secondary education. Must have successfully completed the Zion Intern program in a previous summer. Beginning and ending dates are June 5-Aug. 17, 2023. Work hours vary each week, but are generally from 8 am-1 pm, M-Th, for a total of 150 hours.

We offer compensation based on experience and education. Wages are competitive with those offered in similar positions, and will be discussed in your interview.

- July 31-Aug. 3** Planning and prep week
- Aug. 7-10** Camp Create It
- Aug. 14-17** Post-camp cleaning and projects



Expectations

Interns will participate in all aspects of organizing and leading a variety of day camps, under the supervision of the intern supervisor and individual camp directors. Applicants should be open to expressing their faith, have good organizational skills, be motivated to work with children, and be eager to serve as a team member.

Responsibilities

- Provide a safe environment for children and youth.
- Lead faith formation activities through Bible learning, sports, games, music and crafts.
- Organize and lead youth volunteers (middle and high school).
- Develop positive relationships with parents and staff.
- Prepare materials and supplies for camps.
