#### **CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS:**


Let us confess our sin to God, who is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love.

- 6 O God, our help in ages past, our hope for years to come, still be our guard while troubles last and our eternal home!


