TODAY IS SCOUT SUNDAY

Scouts BSA designates the weekend before February 8 (Scouting Anniversary Day) as Scout Sunday. Scout Sunday is an opportunity for scout units and their faith partners to recognize scouts, scouters, their contributions to the 12th point of the Scout Law, 'Reverence' and to recognize the Packs' earning of the Lutheran Service Award. The Scouting Program seeks to provide opportunities for worship, for study, for service, and for fellowship. The Northern Star Scouting Program uses the P.R.A.Y. program as one means of Christian growth and discipleship. The P.R.A.Y. program requires young people to study scripture and then design service projects to put into action what they have learned. P.R.A.Y. awards feature a four-colored cross. The four colors converge into a point to create an "X" at the center of the cross. "X" is the first letter in the Greek word for Christ, and it is symbolic of how Christ should be at the center of our lives. The four colors correspond to the four levels in the P.R.A.Y. series.

Today we take time to celebrate those who have fulfilled the requirements of the P.R.A.Y. program and deserve recognition for outstanding accomplishment.

CAMP WAPO REGISTRATION IS OPEN!

Camp Wapo is a Bible camp located near Amery, WI, supported by Zion and a number of other Twin Cities area congregations. Zion has reserved openings for the June 14-16 Seeds camp (Gr. 1-3) and the June 16-21 Youth camp (Gr. 4-12). The spots will open to the public on Feb. 15. Zion provides automatic scholarships for all of our campers. Seeds campers receive \$100 per child, 8th grade confirmation campers receive \$400, and all other week-long campers receive \$300. To receive the scholarships, only pay the deposit fee when you register. Zion will then add the scholarship to your account, and you'll be billed for any remainder. Have you not known? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. He gives power to the faint, and strengthens the powerless. Even youths will faint and be weary, and the young will fall exhausted; but those who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Gospel: Mark 1:29-39

As soon as Jesus and the disciples left the synagogue, they entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. Now Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever, and they told him about her at once. Jesus came and took her by the hand and lifted her up. Then the fever left her, and she began to serve them. That evening, at sundown, they brought to Jesus all who were sick or possessed with demons. And the whole city was gathered around the door. And he cured many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him. In the morning, while it was still very dark, Jesus got up and went out to a deserted place, and there he prayed. And Simon and his companions hunted for him. When they found him, they said to him, "Everyone is searching for you." Jesus answered, "Let us go on to the neighboring towns, so that I may proclaim the message there also; for that is what I came out to do." And he went throughout Galilee, proclaiming the message in their synagogues and casting out demons.
