


Silence for reflection







CAMP WAPO REGISTRATION IS OPEN!

Camp Wapo is a Bible camp located near Amery, WI, supported by Zion and a number of other Twin Cities area congregations. Zion has reserved openings for the June 14-16 Seeds camp (Gr. 1-3) and the June 16-21 Youth camp (Gr. 4-12). The spots will open to the public on Feb. 15. Zion provides automatic scholarships for all of our campers. Seeds campers receive \$100 per child, 8th grade confirmation campers receive \$400, and all other week-long campers receive \$300. To receive the scholarships, only pay the deposit fee when you register. Zion will then add the scholarship to your account, and you'll be billed for any remainder. APPLY NOW FOR PAID SUMMER INTERN POSITIONS!

Join a team of young adults who lead kids' day camps, and discover your God-Given superpowers! We offer three types of paid positions with differing start dates and compensation levels: Intern 1 (high school juniors and seniors) and Intern 2 (at least 1 year of post high school education) and Lead Intern (returning). You will work approximately 12-30 hours per week, Monday-Thursdays from mid-June through mid-August. (The week of July 4 is a scheduled break.)
