



#### CAMP WAPO - REGISTER NOW!

Camp Wapo is a Bible camp located near Amery, WI, supported by Zion and a number of other Twin Cities area congregations. Zion dates are June 14-16 Seeds camp (Gr. 1-3) and the June 16-21 Youth camp (Gr. 4-12). Zion provides automatic scholarships for all of our campers. Seeds campers receive \$100 per child, 8th grade confirmation campers receive \$400, and all other week-long campers receive \$300. To receive the scholarships, only pay the deposit fee when you register. Zion will then add the scholarship to your account, and you'll be billed for any remainder. #### **MATTHEW BAGS**

Thank you to all who have generously donated to the Matthew Bag Ministry. You may wonder "Where do these bags go?" Besides parishioners handing them out to those in need, that we see, they also go to the following: Salvation Army store at Northtown, ACBC, Hope4Youth, Anoka Metro Regional Treatment Center, Anoka Ramsey Community College, Anoka Technical College and Hennepin Technical College. Each bag contains water, food bars, personal hygiene items and socks. Again thank you for your continued support.

MORTGAGE REDUCTION OPPORTUNITY Zion's Foundation has made a matching grant of up to \$300,000 available for the purpose of encouraging special gifts toward the eventual elimination of Zion's mortgage. We are pleased to report that special gifts of almost \$100,000 were received in the last two months toward the mortgage reduction effort. With the Foundation's match, we have made a payment of about \$200,000 toward mortgage reduction. This will save about \$200,000 in interest over the remaining life of our loan and allow us to pay our loan off about 2.5 years early. The balance of our mortgage will soon be below \$2 million for the first time in many years. "Mortgage Reduction" envelopes are available at the front desk. Any new gift over and above current pledges in place for our capital appeal, will be matched dollar for dollar by the Zion Foundation over the next 3 years, up to \$300,000. Thank you to all who contribute to the current capital appeal/building fund and to those who have made special gifts to the mortgage reduction effort.
